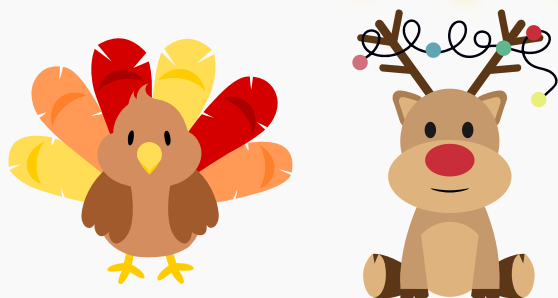

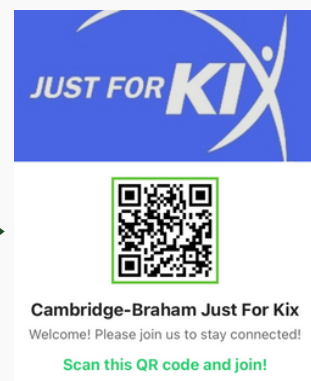
E-MAIL

COSTUMES

WEAR YOUR COSTUME TO CLASS

On December 5th I would like all dancers who have received their costume to wear it to class. This will give us the opportunity to trouble shoot any issues and make sure everyone has the correct pieces ordered. Please wear uniform and all accessories, you can save your tights for show day as long as you ordered them through JFK.

If your dancer does not have her uniform yet, they should just come in regular practice wear. It is not a problem, but you will get a chance to see by observing the others, what they will need and how the uniform should be worn.

Costumes are being delivered on a weekly basis right now. If you receive your costume at class, please try it on as soon as possible. If the costume does not fit and needs to be exchanged, please complete the form on the back of the invoice and follow the return/exchange directions. Costumes cannot be exchanged if they have been worn, are dirty or damaged. The fastest way to get a new costume is to order a new one and send the other one back for a refund. Tights can not be returned if opened. **Please make sure you have all the required pieces!!**

Important information for class

What to wear....

- Dancers can wear any active clothing including leotards, tutus, shorts, leggings, tshirts, or tank tops. Clothing should not be baggy; loose fitting clothing makes it difficult for instructors to see the lines of a dancer's body, which is necessary for proper instruction.
- Shoes are required at class. Please be sure that your dancer has either her dance shoes or tennis shoes each week.
- Hair should be pulled back into a pony tail or bun. If dancer's hair is too short for a pony tail, please have as much of it pulled back out of the face as possible. No jewelry or gum at class please.

Water Bottles:

Please bring a labeled water bottle for dancers in 2-12th grade. Preschool and K-1 dancers do not need a water bottle- please do not send one with them.

Attendance:

Please make practices and performances a priority - your class and team depends on you! If you are absent, meet with a friend to learn the material before the next class.

Supervision:

Dancers are supervised during their regular class time. Although we may have several classes the same day, during the time prior to and after the class you will need to watch your children. We want them safe.

Entering and exiting...

- Dancers should enter and exit through the main entrance. We ask that you do NOT arrive any earlier than 5 minutes before your class starts.
- Parents of dancers in preschool through 3rd grade can walk your dancer into class as well as come to pick them up at the end. Dancers in 4-12th graders can enter on their own (if they are comfortable) and will be dismissed to find their adults at the end of practice.
- We strongly encourage parents to wait in their car after they walk their dancers in and then come back in at the end of classes for pick up. If you must wait- Please no running around or going into various rooms in the building. We are only allowed to be in the practice space and quietly sitting at tables if needed. **PLEASE DO NOT SIT IN THE HALLWAYS!!** Please be respectful of the facility. Pick up after yourself.
- This year we will invite Tiny Kix and Wee Petite parents into the room the last 5 minutes of class. For our 2-12th grade classes we will invite you in the last 5 minutes of class on the last practice of the month. This is subject to change. Dancers focus best with no distractions in the practice space.
- **Please put shoes and coats on in the hallway or entryway so we can start the next class as they run back to back.**
- If dancers are in multiple classes and have a short break, they can wait quietly at the tables between classes and have a snack if needed.
- Dancers may not invite friends who are not enrolled in Just For Kix to the building unless there is a parent present or it has been cleared with me.

WE OFFER A NO DISTRACTION ENVIRONMENT

Over the years, we have found the most productive way to run classes is without the distraction of parents and siblings in the room. We only have a short time each week, so every minute is important. Occasionally I will allow spectators in the last five minutes of class so you can see the progress we are making.

2025-26 EXCITING NEWS

We are reaching out to all dancers who will be in 2nd grade and up (25-26 school year) about our Tampa Performance Tour called the Reliaquest Bowl (formerly the Outback Bowl). Just For Kix organizes the pregame and halftime show for the Reliaquest Bowl in Tampa, FL. They have been leading this production for the past 25+ years! We are offering this optional tour to our dancer Families.

It takes place around the week of December 27th-January 3rd (dates are approx). Dancers learn routines through video, and then head to Florida where we put these productions together in one week! Dancers from all around the country come together. For your tour week, we do excursions like Disney world, a dinner cruise, have a beach day on Clearwater Beach, and of course, PERFORM for a stadium of over 60,000 people!

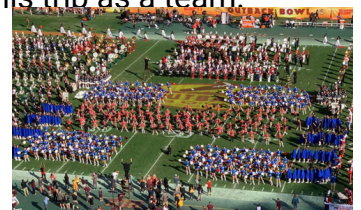
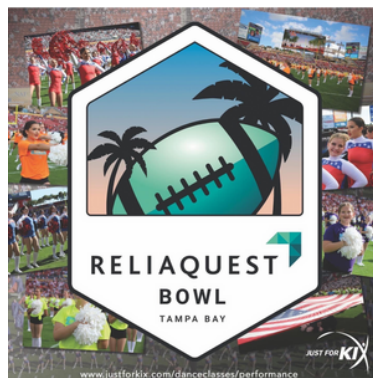
