Leveled classes help to make sure that we keep kids working and advancing at their appropriate level. ALL 6th-12th GRADE DANCERS SHOULD REGISTER FOR SHOOTING STARS JAZZ. THEY WILL BE PLACED IN THE APPROPRIATE CLASS AFTER JAZZ TRYOUTS. DO NOT ORDER JAZZ COSTUMES UNTIL THIS FALL WHEN THEY HAVE BEEN PLACED.*

LYRICAL CLASSES: *Junior Lyrical is full season but starts October 18th or 20th and Senior Lyrical is split into two sessions.*

Southshore Community Center: 5735 Country Club Road, Excelsior MN. Enter main door and we will be to your left down the hall.

CLASS DISCRPTIONS:

TINY KIX: *This class is designed for 3-5 year old dancers. They will work on overall movement while having fun. They will learn basic dance skills, coordination, balance, and following instructions. This class is a great introduction into the world of dance!*

WEE PETITE KIX: *This class is designed for Pre K – K dancers. This class will work on overall movement and basic dance skills. They will work on ballet positions, flexibility, basic turns and jumps, jazz and kick skills.*

WEE KIX/JAZZ COMBO: *This class is designed for 1st-3rd grade dancers. They will work on overall movement and basic dance skills along with basic dance positions, flexibility, turns and jumps, jazz and kick skills. They will compete their jazz routine 2-3x per season.*

MINI KIX: *This class is designed for 4th-5th grade dancers. This class will focus on kick skills appropriate for this age level. This is a competition level class who will compete 3 times during the season.*

MIDDLE KIX: *This class is designed for 6th-7th grade dancers. This class will focus on kick skills appropriate to this age level. This is a competition level class who will compete 3 times during the season.*

SENIOR KIX: *This class is designed for 8th-12th grade dancers. This class will focus on kick skills appropriate to this age level. This is a competition level class who will compete 3 times during the season.*

ADVANCED SENIOR KIX: *This class is designed for 8th-12th grade dancers. This class will focus on advanced kick skills. This class is invite only. This is a competition level class who will compete 3 times during the season.*

MINI JAZZ: *This class is designed for 4th-5th grade dancers. This class will work on basic jazz skills appropriate for this age level. They will learn 1 jazz routine during the year and compete 2 times. This class will be split into two different skill levels at the start of the season.*

SHOOTING STARS JAZZ: *This is a placement jazz class designed for 6th-12th grade dancers. This class is a beginner/intermediate level jazz class. They will learn 1 jazz routine during the year and compete 3 times.*

RISING STARS JAZZ: *This is a placement jazz class designed for 6th-12th grade dancers. This class is an intermediate level jazz class. They will learn 1 jazz routine during the year and compete 3 times.*

STAR MAKERS JAZZ: *This is a placement jazz class designed for 6th-12th grade dancers. This class is an advanced level jazz class. They will learn 1 jazz routine during the year and compete 3 times.*

MIDDLE LYRICAL: *This class is designed for 6th-7th grade dancers. This is a beginner level lyrical class.*

JUNIOR LYRICAL: *This class is designed for 7th-12th grade dancers. This is an intermediate level lyrical class.*

SENIOR LYRICAL: *This class is designed for 8th-12th grade dancers. This is an advanced level lyrical class. It is split into two sessions to accommodate dancers on a high school dance team.*

HIP HOP: *This class is designed for 4th-7th grade dancers. This will be a fast paced class that will work on hip hop and strength skills.*

WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS Kick/Jazz/Lyrical:

Wear tight fittings comfortable clothes you can move in. Jazz pants, shorts, leotards/tights, tank tops, etc. All dancers need to bring their jazz shoes to class. Dancers in 4th-12th grade will also need to bring a pair of tennis shoes to class each week. Hair should always be pulled back tight in a pony tail or bun.

WHAT TO WEAR TO HIP HOP:

Wear tennis shoes or your red costume shoes (please bring these shoes in your bag and never wear them outside of class!). Comfortable clothing that you can easily move in. Shorts, sweat pants, or leggings are fine for the bottom, t-shirt or tank top for the top. No sweatshirts please.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Online Registration -

NEW DANCERS:

1. Go to: classes.justforkix.com

2. Click on “Sign Up” in the Upper right hand corner.

3. Click “Sign up now”

4. Create an account

This will be your family account. You should enter the parents/guardian information here. There will be a place to register individual students later.

5. Do a search on your Zip Code.

Only classes that apply to your child(ren) will show up in the listing. You can further filter the search by day/time or you can search by the course number listed by the class in the registration packet.

6. Add classes and uniform piece that you would like to register for and order. You can check out all at once at the end of the process. Registration and first month payment are due at time of registration.

EXISTING DANCERS: If you have been in our classes in the past year, you have an account to register for the new season. The username for the account is your email. If you do not remember your password, you can reset it on the log in page. Add classes and uniform pieces that you would like to register for. You can check out all at once at the end of the process. Registration and first month payment are due at time of registration.

IMPORTANT COSTUME INFORMATION:

NEW DANCERS: All items must be purchased. With the exception of shoes (if you already have the correct color of jazz shoes). See more information below.

6th-12th GRADE JAZZ: DO NOT purchase your costume for Jazz yet! The dancers will be trying out for a jazz class the first week of class. Once they are placed on a team, then you can go ahead and purchase their jazz costume. Kick, Lyrical and Hip Hop can be ordered now.

FORMER JFK DANCERS: Shoes, bun forms, barrette, and some other costume pieces might be the same as last year. If you plan to use an item from last year, please be sure it is in good condition. Also please be sure the brand is the same. If different, you need to purchase a new one.

SHOES: Dancers can buy jazz shoes online or use their own. They must match the color of the costume online! All other uniform items can be ordered now.

BUN FORMS: Only purchase one - either the blonde or brunette. Best match your dancer's hair color.

TIGHTS: I recommend getting new ones each year. They wear easily from year to year!

REPEAT COSTUMES: Some Jazz and Lyrical costumes might be the same. I have done this to help save money in some instances. Please do not order a costume 2x if you see your dancer wears it for more than one class. Pay attention to all details like color of tights, shoes, etc.

NOTE: Not all costumes match the pictures online exactly. Some have been placed with leggings or shorts when basic pants are shown in the picture. Please order what you are supposed to order with the online check boxes.

ORDERING COSTUMES: I recommend ordering now so you can be first on the list to get your costumes made. Dancers who get their costumes early in the season will have time for exchanges if needed versus those who wait last minute. Costumes take 10-12 weeks to produce. Spring orders will be delivered at class in the fall.
