

If you ordered your costume late in the fall, it may be close to show time by the time it arrives. Do not panic...sometimes it gets crazy but we always manage to come through. If you have a balance on your account, your dancer will be given a slip of paper with the balance owed and your costume will be held until the balance is paid.

Many of you have already received your costume. Please try it on as soon as you receive it. Exchanges can be made if the costume has not been worn.

Please note: Individual families will be responsible for sending uniforms that do not fit back to the office on their own. Please see the back of the blue-colored paper received with the costume for specific instructions. It may take several weeks for exchanges.

Many of the classes have costumes with pants. If your pants are too long, please be sure to hem them to the correct length. It is dangerous to dance in pants that are too long. Inform us of issues ASAP, thank you.

AVOID STRESS and move up your deadlines on shoes, tights, etc. Most people leave it until the day before the show and we cannot promise we will have correct sizes available.

Show Hair & Makeup Tutorial

We will be having a show hair & make up tutorial class for dancers in Kindergarten and up. Parents and dancers will learn and practice how to do DANCE hair & make up guided by one of our instructors!

REHEARSALS: JAZZ PRODUCTION PRACTICE – SUNDAY, DECEMBER 4th • 2:30-4:30pm – JFK Studio

ALL Jazz classes (K-12th grade) will be in the opening number of ALL FOUR of our Winter Shows! Coordinating 11 classes all into 1 dance takes much planning and coordination. To ensure this number will be a success, we will be holding an extra practice the week before the show to practice the transitions between each class. This will be the only practice we have to put all the jazz classes together before the show so this is a VERY IMPORTANT practice to attend! We will do a quick dress rehearsal the day before the show to learn floor spacing. Depending on how quickly the production comes together, we may get done EARLY so plan accordingly!

LYRICAL PRODUCTION PRACTICE – SUNDAY, DECEMBER 4th • 4:45-6:00pm – JFK Studio

All lyrical classes (with the exception of Ballet/Lyrical I) will be in the lyrical production, which will be performing in ALL FOUR of our Winter Shows! We will also be doing a mass practice to go over transitions between the classes and put it all together to ensure its success on the day of the show! Depending on how quickly the production comes together, we may get done EARLY so plan accordingly!

GYM REHEARSAL – SATURDAY, DECEMBER 10th • See times below – Sauk Rapids/Rice High School

We will be having a rehearsal in the GYM to put together our show FINALES and other productions to practice our entrances and exits on the gym floor. We rent out the gym space for this rehearsal so it is VERY IMPORTANT that you make every effort to attend. All dancers who are in a **KICK** class and who are in Kindergarten or older will be in the finale of the show and should attend the finale practice for the show that their KICK class is in!

12:00-12:45 - Show 1 (10:00am show) Finale Practice

12:50-1:20 – Show 2 (1:00pm show) Finale Practice

1:25-1:55 pm – Show 3 (4:00pm show) Finale Practice

2:00-2:30pm – Show 4 (7:00pm show) Finale Practice

2:35-3:15 – Father/Daughter Practice (ALL father/daughter groups should attend)

3:15-4:00pm – Jazz/Lyrical Production Practice (all jazz dancers should attend)

*Finale note: Dancers in Kindergarten and up will learn the finale dance in their kick class. Dancers in Hip Hop, Tap, or Ballet who are not in a kick class and wish to be in the finale can attend a kick class for 3 consecutive weeks prior to the show to learn the dance.
