## UNIFORMS

Costume orders can take 8-12 weeks to come in from the purchase date. Please be patient on your costume order. We will pass them out in class as soon as we receive them in.

Many of you have already received your costume. Please try it on as soon as you receive it. Exchanges can be made if the costume has not been worn.

Please note: Individual families will be responsible for sending uniforms that do not fit back to the office on their own. Please see the back of the blue-colored paper received with the costume for specific instructions. It may take several weeks for exchanges. We recommend requesting a REFUND and then re-ording the size costume you need for a faster turn around time.

AVOID STRESS and move up your deadlines on shoes, tights, hair pieces, etc. Most people leave it until the week before the show and we cannot promise we will have correct sizes available.

## **REHEARSALS:** JAZZ PRODUCTION PRACTICE – SUNDAY, DECEMBER 3<sup>rd</sup> • 2:30-4:30pm – JFK Studio

\*Date change from Year at a Glance calendar to accommodate dancers on High School dance teams and Saturday special sessions ALL Jazz classes (K-12<sup>th</sup> grade) will be in the opening number of ALL FOUR of our Winter Shows! Coordinating 12 classes all into 1 dance takes much planning and coordination. To ensure this number will be a success, we will be holding an extra practice the week before the show to practice the transitions between each class. This will be the only practice we have to put all the jazz classes together before the show so this is a VERY IMPORTANT practice to attend! We will do a quick dress rehearsal the day before the show to learn floor spacing. Depending on how quickly the production comes together, we may get done EARLY so plan accordingly!

## GYM REHEARSAL – SATURDAY, DECEMBER 9th • See times below – Sauk Rapids/Rice High School

We will be having a rehearsal in the GYM to put together our show FINALES and other productions to practice our entrances and exits on the gym floor. We rent out the gym space for this rehearsal so it is VERY IMPORTANT that you make every effort to attend. All dancers who are in a **KICK** class and who are in Kindergarten or older will be in the finale of the show and should attend the finale practice for the show that their KICK class is in!

\*Finale note: Dancers in Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade will learn the finale dance in their kick class. Dancers in Hip Hop, Tap, or Ballet who are not in a kick class and wish to be in the finale can attend a kick class for 3 consecutive weeks prior to the show to learn the dance.
