Bress Code



At Windsor JFK we do not have a strict dress code but encourage dancers to dress appropriately for classes. I have attached a sheet of SUGGESTIONS below, not requirements but to give you some ideas.

Our little dancers wear the little dance outfits you can get from Target, Walmart or Amazon. They love to feel like a little ballerina when coming into the studio! Suggested but not required.

Our older dancers need to wear comfortable athletic clothes to class. HAIR MUST BE UP AND PULLED BACK

If your dancer is in a ballet/lyrical class they need to wear tights and a leotard. When they are doing barre work the instructors can correct body placement easier if they can see the dancers placement easier and baggier clothes hinder that. I would love to see our older dancers in a black leotard or tank top with black bike shorts. Black makes lines so much cleaner.

Remember that shoes/socks must be worn in the studio, no bare feet.

WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS

Appropriate dance clothes are required for class. We want to provide every child the correct feedback and when they have on loose clothing, we may miss something that is important. We are strict about this, so please make sure to have a dance bag packed with extra options.

*Below are EXAMPLES of dance class outfit ideas. Colors and shoes may vary from class to class.

ballet class outfits

TOPS: TIGHTS: SHOES: Black Leotard Pink Tights Ballet



preschool outfits

TOPS: BOTTOMS: SHOES: Leotard Tutu or Shorts Ballet



kick, lyrical & tap class outfits

TOPS: BOTTOMS Leotard or Tight Fitting Top Booty Shorts or Leggings Jazz, Ballet, Tap or Turners



jazz class outfits

TOPS: BOTTOMS: Black Leotard or Tight fitting top (please follow specific colors)
Black Booty Shorts or Black Leggings (please follow specific colors)
1822 or Turners



hip hop class outfits

TOPS: BOTTOMS: SHOES: T-Shirt, Tank Top or Hoodie (loose fitting clothing is accepted)
Booty Shorts, Legging or Pants (loose fitting clothing is accepted)
Sneakers (make sure they are CLEAN)



hair for class high buns required

Hair is also very important. Every dancer's hair must be in a high bun. If they show up with their hair down or in a ponytail, they will be sent to put it up. Bangs must also be back.

Please have your dancers prepared when they come to class.

How To Order Costumes

Costume orders are due by October ist. We will wear the costumes/uniforms for our Winter Show and Spring Show. You will see that most classes also have a maroon Just For Kix sequined t-shirt and a set of gold poms also added in their costume requirements. Those are for our mass performances, if your dancer is 2nd grade and up and is performing at halftime of the CSU Football Game then you need to place your order by September 6th! If you already have ordered them no worries, we actually use them every year and they can keep them and use them later.

When ordering costumes here is the rule of thumb I have used for 10 years and it seems to work great! There is a sizing chart when you are ordering and you can measure and order accordingly to sizing recommended.

Log Into your dancers account and go under the purchase uniform tab on the left.

Costumes-Order one size larger than street clothes size Jazz and Ballet Shoes- Order 2 sizes larger than street shoe size

Hip Hop Shoes- Order one size larger than street shoes, they do not come in half sizes.

Tap Shoes-True to size

Hip Hop Jackets-True to size

Hip Hop Joggers-True to size



If you would like to have your dancer sized by staff rather than going off the above information please do the following:

Give a index card to your dancer to give to their instructor or hand the instructor the index card at drop off and please include:

Dancers Name-

Dancers Class-

What you would like sized (costume, shoes)

The instructor will then size the dancers during class time and give the index card back to the dancer.

When costumes arrive they are delivered to the studio and then separated by class. They will be given to the instructor to distribute at class time. You are able to track the progress of your order under your dancers account. If you look under order history you will be able to see if it is pending, or fulfilled and what date it was fulfilled on. Just a note, the date it was fulfilled on is not the date I will receive it. I get shipments sent to me every Wednesday and it takes until Monday of that next week until I receive that shipment. Reminder that costume orders are due by October ist!

What if my dancers shoes have not come in yet and I have already ordered? No worries, dancers can wear socks until your dance shoes are ordered and arrive. Sneakers can be worn for hip hop classes. Tap shoes can be ordered. If you have already ordered your tap shoes through JFK then I should have them soon. I have my first shipment arriving this Monday!

When you receive your dancers costume try them on right away and make sure they fit! Exchanges can be done if time allows before show time! My suggestion after you make sure they fit and all is good, is to then hang them up in a safe place in the closet.

If you really want to be on top of it you can steam them and put them in a garment bag including tights and hair pieces that way they are all in one place and ready for show day!
