MEETING AREA

Our meeting area is the Aux Gym. We ask that ONE parent please drop dancers off and then go find a seat. Our meeting area is shared by many programs there (lots of kids), we don't have a lot of space, so we ask that you are not waiting around in it. **Our spot is for dancers and coaches only**. **Parents and dancers can not be waiting in this area between arrival times.** Just For Kix really wants us to be mindful of this!! Please drop your dancer off and find your seat. We love that friends/boyfriends are coming to support dancers, however, they should NOT be in our meeting spot. Thank you for being respectful of this.

HOW DO I FIND MY DANCER AFTER THE COMPETITION?

Please meet your dancer back in the Aux Gym after awards are done. Please do **NOT** take them from the gym floor. We need them to walk back to our meet spot as a team.

MESSAGE TO PARENTS



Competition Hair

2nd-12th grade will wear hair in a slicked back low bun with a middle part. See picture below. We want hair extremely slicked back using gel and hairspray. No Fly aways please. Buns should be at the nape of your neck please and not higher and secured with bobby pins, a hair net and hair spray. We are going for a 'wet' look. Arrive with hair done.



Competition Makeup

Dancers should wear performance makeup. This includes foundation, blush, brown eyeshadow, and red lipstick. We also highly encourage false lashes!You can get these supplies at many stores or amazon.The reason for wearing performance makeup is so their facial expressions are seen from the judges area! Make sure you have your dancer earring- you can order these in your dance account. They have pierced and clip on.



No Jewelry, Glitter or Nail Polish

Dancers will need to take off all jewelry. This includes earrings, necklaces, bracelets and any face jewelry as well. Exception is competition earrings purchased. All nail polish and fake nails will need to be removed before competition. No glitter is allowed.

What to Wear

Dancers should bring all costume pieces. Make sure your tights are free from any tears. You have all shoes needed. You have all accessories and poms needed.

Make sure your undergarments cannot be seen with your costume and are nude to your skin tone.

Reminder: No bare midrift skin can show for TWD competitions. Please make sure hip-hop classes are wearing black leotards underneath. Please make sure all teams in black pants are wearing tall black socks.



Entry Fees

2025 Entry Fees will be billed into your accounts prior to each competition. ALL FEES MUST BE PAID FOR 1 WEEK PRIOR TO THE EVENT IN ORDER FOR DANCERS TO PARTICIPATE- THIS IS A FIRM DEADLINE.

There will be no admissions fee for spectators at any of the TWD Competitions. This means all spectators can walk right in and enjoy the competition. Invite as many people as you would like to come watch


