

WHAT IS SPRING SHOW?

An opportunity for ALL Byron JFK dancers to showcase what they have worked on through the last 3 months with their team(s). Our younger classes will feature show themed routines, while competition teams will showcase their TWD routines. Spring Show traditions like Momsters and Senior Partner dance will be featured, in addition to a new tradition of a production opening routine and completing the show will be K-3rd finale and 4-I2th LIGHT ROUTINE Finale! Please cheer on these amazing dancers!

Rehearsals

Attending show rehearsals is VITAL for the success of your dancer. If you are unable to attend rehearsals you MUST communicate with Director.

PRO-PACKING

Pack for the show one week before the event + make sure ALL UNIFORM ITEMS ARE LABELED! Note anything missing or needed-uniforms, hair supplies, make up, extra tights, mirror, etc. If a dancer has multiple costume changes, please make sure all uniform items are labeled and arranged in performance order. I recommend large ziplocks for each costume and accessories + using a large open bin/laundry basket. Quick changes are a MUST! Staff will be available for quick things, but dancers are responsible for their own changes and what is needed when. All personal items should be kept tidy and stored in a personal bag/basket.

COSTUME CHANGES

*PreK-Ist grade dancers that need to change uniforms MUST have ONE parent present in the staging area for assistance. Once changed and back with staff, parents may return to their seats.

*2nd-12th grade dancers will have an assigned prep/changing area. Dancers new to changing uniforms for an event need to practice at home on how to do this - make it a fun game! A parent is welcome to assist with a younger dancer if needed, but we hope that with practicing at home he/she will be okay on their own.

Uniforms, Etc.

*Dancers should have NO jewelry, nail polish, or gum

HAIR AND MAKEUP

HAIR & Tiny, Wee-Petites, K-2 Pom:

If possible- sleek bun at the crown/top of head. Hair piece secured on top of bun. Performance makeup optional!

HAIR

2nd-12th grade: Low bun slicked back with a CENTER PART secured with hair net - no fly aways! Hair piece on top of bun if applicable.

MAKEUP \Rightarrow 2nd-12th grade:

Performance make-up highly is encouraged.
Competition teams are required. Remember we are
ENHANCING OUR BEAUTY NOT CHANGING OUR
BEAUTY- foundation, blush, neutral smokey eye,
mascara and red lipstick.

WHAT TO WEAR

- ☼ Opener: Show shirt, black shorts, tan tights/shoes
- ☆ K-3rd Finale: Show shirt (can wear over costume)
- **☆ 4-12th Finale LIGHTS:** All black long sleeve
- ☼ Momsters: Show shirt + black bottoms
- ☆ Class routines: Team uniform

NOTE: Routines that use props- props will be provided on show day

DOORS OPEN- Please use main entrance. General Seating will open when rehearsals have concluded, estimated time of II:45am. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

SEATING- We will have a FULL CROWD and there will be enough seating for EVERYONE! There is NO assigned seating, with the exception of volunteers and handicap locations.

ADMISSION- THERE IS LIMITED GATE ADMISSION!
You must present your ticket(s) at time of show

You must present your ticket(s) at time of show admittance. Pre-sale tickets distributed in class.

DURING THE SHOW- Once the show begins, please refrain from moving during the performance. If you must leave your seat, please do so in-between numbers. WE ARE FAMILY- respect one another, be kind and helpful, support all teams and coaches and CHEER LOUD! Applause is welcome. When you see something you like while a team is performing, let them know. A dance show is an interactive experience!

DISMISSAL-Tiny Kix: return to parents immediately following their performance to watch the show. One parent should be with their dancer until they perform + will view the performance from the front.

<u>K-3rd</u>: will remain with their class in staging areas. Following the K-3rd finale, these dancers will join their families in the stands.

4-12th: will remain with their class in staging areas. After the LIGHT ROUTINE finale, which concludes our show + encompasses all classes 4-12th, older dancers are free to meet their families. Make sure to arrange a meeting place prior to dropping your dancer off.
