## Sept-Oct 2017 News:

#### Welcome to the World of Dance!!!!

We are SO EXCITED to have your little person dancing with us. This is my 22nd year directing and I think I love it more now than ever, so thank you for bringing your child!

**CALENDARS:** this month you will receive two bi-monthly calendars. This one, and the big one that goes to the whole program. After this calendar, the hope is to just give the preschool-1st grade the Tutu Tots bi-monthly calendar (this one). Who needs more papers, right?

**BATHROOM**: be sure to bring your dancer to the bathroom before class. If one needs to go, they all need to go:) Thank you!

**COMMUNICATION:** your child is important to us. You are busy. We are busy. To help our year go smoother, please take time to read the handouts and emails. Communication is an IMPORTANT part of our success.

WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS: Please have your dancer dressed like a dancer--leotards, tutus, leggings, jazz shorts, snug fitting stretchy clothes. When your child's dance shoes arrive, please wear those to class every week! Proper clothes are important--can you imagine if a football player went to practice in flip flops & jeans?? Crazy!! Thank you in advance.

**HAIR AT CLASS:** This is important--hair needs to be pulled up and off the face. A bun is preferred, but a high ponytail or braids are acceptable too. Loose hair should be secured off the face with bobby pins/barrettes/headbands. When hair is down, your dancer can't see as well, it can hit them in the face when working on turns, and it's just a distraction for them. I realize you may have "those days" when you are in a rush and things don't go as planned. I understand that--I have 4 kids. A HUGE thank you, however, for really trying to adhere to this policy.
