1. November Tuition / Student Accounts:

Your November tuition is now due. If you haven't yet done so, please log into your account and make your payment today. <u>www.justforkix.com/danceclasses</u> and then select **Make Payment / Classes**. All accounts are due by the 1st of the month.

Reminders:

- You won't receive a monthly billing for your tuition payments. Accounts past due will receive a monthly

statement from the home office.

- Payments are due by the 1st of the month

- Late Fees: the late fee is \$10.00.

2. Communication Tips

All student communication should filter through me by email, band or phone. I make sure instructors are kept in the loop on absences, concerns, feedback, etc. I've had a few questions regarding the option for contacting teachers separately, but I want to make sure I'm being very respectful of their time as they all work another job during the day. Please continue to communicate with me and I will make sure things are forwarded appropriately.

Also, I only see my email when I'm actually at my computer; I don't use my phone for email. If you email me during class time, I will respond to your question the following day. If your need is urgent (during class time), the best option is to text me and I should see it and be able to respond that night.

3. Costumes

I am currently tracking outstanding items with coaches and our home office.

If you haven't yet tried on your dancer's costume, PLEASE PLEASE PLEASE, take care of that today. My last box shipping back to the home office prior to our show will be this Friday, November 8. After November 8 anything that needs to be exchanged will need to be sent back for a refund and a new item (correct size) will need to be ordered ASAP.

<u>TIGHTS</u>: All dancers need to order tights through your dancer's account with JFK. Not all tights have the same color and we want a uniform look when the dancers perform. Please check the size before you open you package as tights cannot be exchanged or returned once the package has been opened. The sizing grid is on the back of the package.

Costume Rehearsal: All dancers in grades PreK-7 should wear their costume to class the week of November 18; DO NOT wear the performance tights to class. If your dancer is still waiting for their costume, we will have it that week and you can slip it on before class begins. We like them to have a chance to see how their costume feels when they are dancing. *Dancers in grades 8-12 should wear all black to their classes the week of November 18*.
