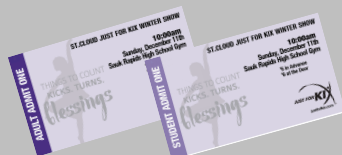

This includes: tights, shoes, hair accessories and costume pieces so that we can be aware of who is still in need of their costume and you can be aware of any last minute purchases that need to be made! (Twinklers, Starlites, Showstoppers & Starmakers do not need to wear costumes.) Jazz classes should wear their Jazz Production Costume to class.

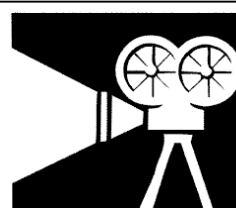

Got Tights?

Check for tights, shoes, barrettes, earrings, etc.

Dancers are encouraged to lie out all show items and get them organized at least 1 week before the show to avoid last minute panic.

HAIR ON SHOW DAY

- **Preschool**– ½ up and curly
- **K-5th Grade**– Left part, low bun with bun form, curly hair piece (purchase in studio store), barrette on right side of bun. **Mississippi Heights & Pleasantview dancers do not need fake hair piece.
- **6-12th Grade** – high bun (no bun form), barrette underneath bun
- All hair accessories will be worn on the right side unless otherwise instructed

MEETING LOCATIONS: ON SHOW DAY

- Preschool (Tiny, Pre Petites, & Teeny's): Meet in front of sound table 10 minutes before show time OR at intermission. One parent will stay on floor with dancer and take dancer back to sit with them when finished performing. **Thurs Tiny Tap/Ballet:** Please meet in the commons during intermission of show 4
- K-12th Grade classes: Auxiliary Gym (Find your class sign)
- Showstoppers, Starmakers, & Rising Stars: Girls Locker Room
- Twinklers, Starlites, & Shooting Stars: Boys Locker Room
- Senior Kix – Top Balcony of Aux Gym

****Boys are not allowed in the meeting locations** due to dancers having to change. Male dancers will wait for their class in the back hallway near the dancer's entrance. There will be a changing tent in this area available for male dancers.

****Be sure to label EVERYTHING!** All costume pieces and clothing items dancers wear to the show should be labeled with their name and what class they are in

Note: There will be NO food or drinks allowed in the staging areas, thank you!

QUICK CHANGES

- Be organized. Using a clear tub/bin allows you to find items easier.
- Label everything!!!! (Especially shoes.)
- Have all needed supplies. (Gel, bobby pins, clips, binders, hair net, bun form, safety pins, make up, hair spray)
- Have a plan for how child will change without help. Practice it at home. Dancers 3rd grade and younger who are in multiple dances should have a large Ziploc bag, labeled with their child's name, that has the contents of their 2nd costume. This will help staff/volunteers help them quickly if need be.
- Have an order of performance, with your dances highlighted, hung in your space of the meeting area or on the inside cover of your dance bin.
- There will be a curtain changing area in the back gym for dancers with quick changes (1-2 songs between dances). Have a friend ready to help you as you run off the floor.
- **Come with make up and hair done.**
- Items frequently forgotten: extra tights, safety pins, hair accessories
- Speed is important, dancers should not hold up the show!

WHAT TO EXPECT: ON SHOW DAY

PARKING

With a large number of families arriving at the same time, parking can get crazy. All dancers and spectators will enter through Door 6 on the West side of the high school.

ADMISSION

Remember to have your pre-sale tickets available to give to the door monitors. Pre-Sale ticket holders, DO NOT wait in the admission lines, go directly to the doors. Tickets are \$9.00 for adults and \$6.00 for students on the day of the show.

SEATING

We will have a full crowd, but we hope with the addition of a 4th show, there will be enough seats for everyone. Our routines are choreographed to be viewed from above, so every seat in the gym is a good one. We ask that the floor seats are reserved for parents of our Teeny Kix (3-5yr olds) and families that have a member unable to climb in the bleachers.

DURING THE SHOW

Once the show has begun, please refrain from moving while a team is performing. If you must leave your seat, please do so in-between numbers.

Applause is welcome. When you see something you like while the team is performing, let them know. A dance performance is an interactive experience.

AFTER THE SHOW

Our last number will be the finale' which encompasses all classes K-12th. Our staff will lead K-3rd graders back to the Auxiliary gym to be picked up. Dancers 4th grade and up may remain in the gym to be greeted by their family.

BETWEEN SHOWS

We will be clearing the gym after each show. If you are attending multiple shows, please make sure to exit the gym and re-enter with the next shows ticket. Seats will not be allowed to be saved with blankets or jackets. Thank you for your cooperation.



WHAT TO WEAR

....If I'm in the Opening Jazz Production

- Ugly Christmas Sweater
- Black Booty Shorts (available for purchase in the studio store)
- Tan tights
- Tan jazz shoes

....If I'm in the Lyrical Production

- Regular lyrical costume

....If I'm in Father/Daughter

- Preschool – Kindergarten
 - Winter/Ice Fishing theme: Ideas of things to wear include flannel, vests, mittens, ear muffs, winter hats, boots
- 1st-3rd Grade
 - Dancers: Pink dress (purchased through dance account), tan tights, tan jazz shoes
 - Dads: White button up shirt, black dress pants, black bow tie, black shoes
- 4th-6th Grade:
 - Dancers: Blue dress (purchased through dance account), tan tights, tan jazz shoes
 - Dads: White button up shirt, black dress pants, black bow tie, black shoes
- 7th-12th Grade:
 - Dancers: White long-sleeved leotard, white puffy skirt (get at dress rehearsal on the 10th), tan tights, tan jazz shoes
 - Dads: White button up shirt, black dress pants, black bow tie, black shoes

....If I'm in Contemporary

- Black or maroon dress

....If I'm in Shooting Stars/Rising Stars Ballet

- Pink Tights, Black Leotard, pink ballet shoes or turners

....If I'm in Light Routine

- All black – leggings/sweat pants, black shoes/socks, long sleeved black leotard/tshirt

....If I'm in All Boys Class

- Superhero costume of your choice

....If I'm in the Finale

- Whatever costume you are in LAST in the show. No need to change back into a specific costume.



JANUARY SPECIAL SESSIONS:

- **Adult Ballet Fitness – Tuesday – 5:30-6:30**
5-week session designed for adults to switch up your ordinary workout routine. Tone, strengthen & stretch muscles as well as use the barre for conditioning exercises! Class begins Jan 10th through Tuesday Feb 7th.
Cost: \$47.50
- **Teeny Kix – Thursday – 4:30-5:15**
This 6-week session is designed for 3-5 year old dancers looking to try out dance class without the full year commitment. Dancers will learn various skills as well as a dance to perform at our Family & Friends Show on March 4th! Class begins January 26-March 2nd.
Cost: \$57
- **Musical Theatre – Friday – 6:00-7:00**
This 8-week session is designed for dancers in 5th-12th grade. Dancers will gain additional training in jazz technique but the class will also help dancers take their performance and style to the next level! Class will perform at the Family & Friends show on March 4th.
