

E-MAIL

Class Pictures



We will be holding our class photos on Feb 2nd and 5th- please save the date. We hold picture night on a regular class night as we know your lives are busy and we want all dancers in attendance. Picture envelopes will be distributed the week or two prior to pictures at class. They will also have pictures forms the day of pictures. Pictures are optional but we would like all dancers to come dressed in uniform to participate in the group photo even if they are not ordering photos. Dancers may wear their hair however you would like for photos but should come in complete uniform.

We stick to a pretty firm schedule that evening. **The time is the time your group picture will be taken. Please do NOT be late. Please arrive about 10 minutes before your group picture time.** We ask that you take the group picture FIRST and then get in line for individual and sister/buddy pictures. It will help us keep our time frame running smoothly.

Please be patient as we are getting 20-30 dancers at a time for pictures so it will take some time. It's not an in and out time frame expect to be there about an hour (sometimes it goes way faster sometimes a little longer). You are free to leave once you're done with your group and individual picture. We do not practice- Due to a scheduling conflict at the school, Thursday pictures will be held at the Free Church (Monday will still be at the school)



Important information for class

What to wear....

- Dancers can wear any active clothing including leotards, tutus, shorts, leggings, tshirts, or tank tops. Clothing should not be baggy; loose fitting clothing makes it difficult for instructors to see the lines of a dancer's body, which is necessary for proper instruction.
- Shoes are required at class. Please be sure that your dancer has either her dance shoes or tennis shoes each week.
- Hair should be pulled back into a pony tail or bun. If dancer's hair is too short for a pony tail, please have as much of it pulled back out of the face as possible. No jewelry or gum at class please.

Water Bottles:

Please bring a labeled water bottle for dancers in K-12th grade. Preschool dancers do not need a water bottle- please do not send one with them.

Attendance:

Please make practices and performances a priority - your class and team depends on you! If you are absent, meet with a friend to learn the material before the next class.

Supervision:

Dancers are supervised during their regular class time. Although we may have several classes the same day, during the time prior to and after the class you will need to watch your children. We want them safe.

Entering and exiting...

- Dancers should enter and exit through the main entrance. We ask that you do NOT arrive any earlier than 5 minutes before your class starts.
- Parents of dancers in preschool through 3rd grade can walk your dancer into class as well as come to pick them up at the end. Dancers in 4-12th graders can enter on their own (if they are comfortable) and will be dismissed to find their adults at the end of practice.
- We strongly encourage parents to wait in their car after they walk their dancers in and then come back in at the end of classes for pick up. If you must wait- **Please no running around or going into various rooms in the building. The locker bays are off limits. Per the schools request we are only able to sit in the hallway between the gyms. Please be respectful of the facility. If we can not follow this we don't be able to allow anyone to wait in the school and I don't want this to happen.**
- This year we will invite Tiny Kix and Wee Petite parents into the room the last 5 minutes of class. For our 2-12th grade classes we will invite you in the last 5 minutes of class on the last practice of the month. This is subject to change. Dancers focus best with no distractions in the practice space.
- Dancers may not invite friends who are not enrolled in Just For Kix to the building unless there is a parent present or it has been cleared with me.

WE OFFER A NO DISTRACTION ENVIRONMENT

Over the years, we have found the most productive way to run classes is without the distraction of parents and siblings in the room. We only have a short time each week, so every minute is important. Occasionally I will allow spectators in the last five minutes of class so you can see the progress we are making.
