
WELCOME

BAND APP

BAND is our PRIMARY SOURCE of communication. Here you will find reminders, weather cancellations, newsletters and ALL important Northfield JFK things you'll need to know throughout the season!

EMAIL

We will occasionally send out emails throughout the season. Please make sure we have your most current email address on file in your dancer's account. If you aren't receiving emails, check your promotions, junk mail or spam folders as they sometimes end up there.

NEED TO KNOW

Early is on time - on time is late. Just For Kix teams start on time! Please put forth your best effort to come prepared and ready to dance! Every dancer is needed from COUNT ONE to make a true practice or performance effective.

CLASS ATTIRE

Please check the WHAT TO WEAR document on our website and in BAND. We need dancers to be in clothing that allows for a wide range of movement. No jewelry, gum, etc. Hair needs to be pulled back into a low bun (required for competition dancers) or ponytail.

ATTENDANCE

Please make practices and performances a priority - your team depends on you! If you have to miss practice, please meet with a friend or watch the practice videos in BAND to get caught up before the next class.

SUPERVISION

Dancers are supervised during their scheduled class time. There are multiple classes scheduled back-to-back, and we are not able to supervise children before or after class. Please do not drop dancers off any more than 5 minutes later, and please be there to pick them up when class is finished. Their safety is our biggest priority, and we want to make sure that no dancers are left unsupervised.

TUITION

There are two easy ways to make your payments:

- 1. Make a payment within your dance account at www.justforkix.com/danceclasses. This is the fastest, easiest way to make payments and manage your dancer's account!
- 2. Call the JFK Home Office at (218)829-7107. They are open Monday-Thursday 10am-4pm and Friday 10am-12pm.
- Monthly payments are due by the 1st of each month.
- There will be a \$10.00 fee assessed to late payments.
- Dancer accounts must be paid in full prior to participating in classes and performances.

AUTO PAY

Auto pay is a wonderful feature we offer! In your account, click *Make A Payment* and make sure to check the box under *Auto Pay*. You will need to check the box for each individual class.

CANCELLATIONS

In the event that we must cancel classes, we will make the announcement in several locations including BAND, Northfield JFK Facebook & Instagram, and via email.

COSTUMES

Costume orders are due by September 30th. If you have not ordered your costumes, please be sure your dancer is sized by a coach, and order as soon as you are able. Costumes are shipped to the Director, and will be distributed at class.

If you still need to order your costume:


Costumes need to be paid in full when the order is placed. Some costumes can take 8-12 weeks to arrive, so order early to ensure timely delivery prior to our Winter Show.

When you receive your costume:

Try it on right away. If the sizing is incorrect, we will need to take care of it right away to ensure we get the correct size back in time for performances. Exchanges and returns can be done as long as the costume has not been worn or damaged. Tights can only be exchanged if they are unopened.

SIZING TIPS

If your dancer has not been sized for costumes, please view the sizing guides when ordering costumes. If you need a second opinion, our coaching staff is happy to help!



RETURNS/EXCHANGES

If your costumes or shoes don't fit:

RETURN FOR REFUND/ORDER NEW RIGHT AWAY: This is recommended, so you receive the correct size faster! Please fill out the back of the invoice completely, and follow the instructions to get the RMA # (selecting return for refund, new size ordered). Once this is completed, you can give the form and costume to a coach, and we will ship it back for you.

EXCHANGE FOR A NEW SIZE: This can take 3-4 weeks before the new item is sent back. If you choose to exchange your item, you will need to fill out the back of the invoice, and follow the instructions to the get the RMA # (selecting exchange and choosing a new size). You will then need to send it back to the JFK Home Office using the address on the back of the invoice. Pleas send your items back in a timely manner, to ensure you receive the new item in time for any upcoming performances.

We will only ship back returns - coaches will assume a new size has been ordered if you give us something to ship back to the JFK Home Office.
