

Becker Dance Together Show Newsletter - 2025

Date and Location: Friday, November 14th, 2025 at the Becker High School Gym

Show Time: 6:00pm

Tickets: This is a fundraiser for the Becker High School Dance Team! Admission for the show will be \$10/adults, \$5/students and seniors age 65+, age 4 and under FREE (dancers are free too!); at the door admission only.

Raffle/Food Shelf Donation: A donation of 5 nonperishable items donated to the food shelf items will automatically enter you into a raffle drawing to receive a basket of local goodies valued at approximately \$100!

Entering the Facility: Dancers and spectators should use the door labeled “PAC and Gymnasium” near the flagpole; this is the only door that will be unlocked.

Gym Doors Open: Gym doors will open for spectators to enter at 5:45pm.

Approximate Length of Show: Some years this show gets long, and as guests we have no control over the speed of the show. Typically, proper “dance etiquette” is to stay for the entire show; however, we know that many of you have young kiddos and this show can get late. For those in the first half of the show, know that there will be a 10-15 minute intermission halfway through the show. For those who are finished performing, this is the best time to exit if you feel your family cannot stay through the entire show.

Dancers – what to do when you arrive: Dancers should arrive at the arrival time listed below, dressed in their costume with hair done. Please arrive a few minutes early to get situated, use the bathroom, etc.

***Preschool dancers should be dropped off with instructors in the North Commons; JFK staff will be waiting in the main hallway to help lead you there.

***K-3rd grade dancers can drop off belongings in the North Commons if you would like, then should sit with their parents to watch the first half of the show. Please meet me/Just For Kix staff in the hallway outside of the gym at intermission to take dancers back to line up for their performance. It is important that dancers come meet us right away so we have enough time to get everyone ready!

Two-Sided Show/Where to Sit: This is a two-sided show, meaning that there will be seating on both sides of the gym. All JFK performances will face the same way so that you can see all of your dancers from the front, if you have kiddos in more than one class. Please sit on Side A, the left side (the larger set of bleachers) upon entering the gym.

Class Details – Arrival Times, Uniforms, Hair:

Fall Teeny Kix (2-4 yr olds) – Arrive at 5:40pm

Hair: hair can be styled however you’d like, add the hairpiece

Uniform: blue skirted leo, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, blue hair bow

Monday Tiny Kix (3-5 yr olds) and Thursday Tiny Kix (3-5 yr olds) – Arrive at 5:40pm

Hair: hair curled (to the best of your ability – hair that is braided wet the night before then taken out before the show works great too!), front half pulled up into a half ponytail and hairpiece added in front of the ponytail

Uniform: gold skirted leo, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, gold hair bow

Monday Wee Petites (K-1st gr) and Thursday Wee Petites (K-1st gr) – Arrive at 5:45pm to drop off belongings – sit with parents for first half then meet instructors in the hallway at start of intermission:

Hair: hair curled (to the best of your ability – hair that is braided wet the night before then taken out before the show works great too!), front half pulled up into a half ponytail and hairpiece added in front of the ponytail

Uniform: mint biketard, mint tutu, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, pink hair bow

Monday Wee Kix (2-3rd gr) and Thursday Wee Kix (2-3rd gr) – Arrive at 5:45pm to drop off belongings– sit with parents for first half then meet instructors in the hallway at start of intermission:

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: magenta biketard, high waisted leggings, black jazz shoes, hair piece

***Make-up is optional for these age groups! If you choose for your dancer to wear make-up, lipstick helps enhance a dancer's smile/facials as they perform!

Please remove all jewelry ***including earrings, for all performances. The only exception is if your dancer's ears have been recently pierced and are therefore required to keep starters in.
