

Becker Winter Show 2026 Newsletter

Date and Location: Sunday, January 11th 2026 at the Becker High School Gym

Show Times: 2:30pm and 5:00pm

*** Monday Tiny Kix (ages 3-5 yrs old, not yet in K), Monday Wee Petites (K-1st gr), Monday Wee Kix (2-3rd gr), Monday Wee Jazz/Hip Hop (K-3rd gr), Mini Jazz/Lyrical (4-5th gr), Jr. Lyrical (6-12th gr), and Jr. Pom (6-12th gr) - dance at the 2:30pm show ONLY.

*** Winter Teeny Kix (2-4 yr olds, short term class), Thursday Tiny Kix (ages 3-5 yrs old, not yet in K), Thursday Wee Petites (K-1st gr), Thursday Wee Kix (2-3rd gr), Thursday Wee Jazz/Hip Hop (K-3rd gr), Mini Pom (4-5th gr), Mini Hip Hop (4-5th gr), Jr. Hip Hop (6-12th gr), and Jr. Jazz (6-12th gr) - dance at the 5:00pm show ONLY.

*** Mini Kix (4-5th gr), Middle Kix (6-7th gr), Senior Kix (8-12th gr), PreK Father/Dancer, Mother/Dancer, Winter Lights, K-3rd grade Pom - dance at both shows!

Tickets: At-the-door ticket pricing is \$10/adult and \$8/students, age 5 and under are free. If you ordered discounted presale tickets they will be handed out after your dancer's kick class the week of the show. Preschool-5th grade – a parent must come inside to pick up the tickets; 6-12th graders may take tickets if you so choose!

Flowers and Show Shirts: Roses (\$3) will be available for purchase. Show shirts will be available for \$27 per shirt; show shirts can also be ordered through your dancer's account!

Entering the Facility: Dancers and spectators should use the door labeled "PAC and Gymnasium" near the flagpole; this is the only door that will be unlocked.

Gym Doors Open: Gym doors will enter 20 minutes prior to each show time.

Approximate Length of Show: Each show will be approximately 1 hour long.

Dancers – what to do when you arrive: Dancers should arrive at the arrival time listed for their class on the back of this newsletter, dressed in their costume with hair done. Please arrive a few minutes early to get situated. If your dancer doesn't need to change costumes drop off your belongings in the cafeteria; dancers who will need to change costumes - drop off your things in the classroom in the hallway behind the gym. Report to the gym at the arrival times listed for your class. If dancers have multiple costume changes, we suggest using a laundry basket to organize, rather than a bag.

LABEL EACH COSTUME PIECE WITH YOUR DANCER'S NAME – I cannot stress this enough! Practice changing costumes QUICKLY at home (2 minutes or less) as this is what they will have to do on their own at the show. If dancers need help changing, a female family member will need to come out of the stands to help them as staff will be busy with classes. Once dancers are dropped off, they will stay with their class until the show is over. We don't want them in the hallway and commons area without their instructor at any time.

What to Expect...

Parking: With a large number of families arriving at the same time parking can get crazy. Please plan ahead and give yourself time to park and walk into the building on time!

Admission: Please have your pre-sale tickets and/or cash ready to give to the admission takers. If buying tickets at the door, we can only accept cash and we ask that you avoid paying with bills larger than \$20 as it greatly depletes our change supply. Your hand will be marked so we know that you are able to enter the show.

Seating: We will have a full crowd but we will have enough seats for everyone. I am expecting that our 2:30pm show will be more full than the 5:00pm show; please plan to scoot in and not leave any open space between families. Our routines are choreographed to be viewed from above, so every seat in the gym is a good one! We ask that the floor seats are reserved for families that have a member unable to climb the bleachers.

During the Show: Once the show has begun, please refrain from moving while a team is performing. If you must leave your seat, please do so in between numbers. Applause is WELCOME and ENCOURAGED! When you see something you like while a team is performing, cheers and applause pushes a team to do even better! A dance show is an interactive experience!

After the Show: Preschool dancers will sit with their families for the remainder of the show following their last performance. Our last number will be the mass routine, which encompasses all classes K-12th grade. We will then gather for a program picture, and we will call the preschoolers back down to be in the photo. After the picture, I will ask that preschoolers be picked up by a parent from the floor before anybody else moves from their seat. Then I will release 4-12th graders to go meet their parents in the bleachers or in another spot that you designate with your dancer before dropping them off. Our staff will stay on the floor with our K-3rd grade dancers until a parent comes down to the floor to pick them up. We will then need to clear the gym before spectators for the second show may enter; please bring all belonging with you if you are attending both shows (no saving seats for the second show unless you are a volunteer).

Class Details – Arrival Times, Uniforms, Hair...

If your dancer is dancing at both shows, they should report to the cafeteria to line up for the second show at 4:40pm.

Winter Teeny Kix (2-4 yr olds) – Arrive at 4:40pm – meet in Cafeteria, not the gym

Hair: hair can be styled however you'd like, please incorporate the hair piece

Uniform: Blue skirted leo, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, blue hair bow

Monday Tiny Kix (3-5 yr olds) – Arrive at 2:10pm – meet in Cafeteria, not the gym

Thursday Tiny Kix (3-5 yr olds) – Arrive at 4:40pm – meet in Cafeteria, not the gym

Hair: hair curled (to the best of your ability – hair that is braided wet the night before then taken out before the show works great too!), front half pulled up into a half ponytail and hairpiece added in front of the ponytail

Uniform: Gold skirted leo, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, gold hair bow

Monday Wee Petites (K-1st gr) – Arrive at 1:55pm

Thursday Wee Petites (K-1st gr) – Arrive at 4:25pm

Hair: hair curled (to the best of your ability – hair that is braided wet the night before then taken out before the show works great too!), front half pulled up into a half ponytail and hairpiece added in front of the ponytail

Uniform: Mint leo, mint tutu, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, pink and mint bow

Monday Wee Kix (2-3rd gr) – Arrive at 1:45pm

Thursday Wee Kix (2-3rd gr) – Arrive at 4:15pm

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: Magenta biketard, black leggings, black jazz shoes, magenta sequin bow, NO socks ***black socks from home will be worn for competition!

Monday Wee Jazz/Hip Hop (K-3rd gr) – Arrive at 1:45pm

Thursday Wee Jazz/Hip Hop (K-3rd gr) – Arrive at 4:15pm

Hair: same as your dancer's kick class; add hair piece with the ponytail or bun

Uniform: **FOR JAZZ ROUTINE (not performing jazz at this show, but most pieces are also used for hip hop)** – Mint leo, mint tutu, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, pink and mint bow; **FOR HIP HOP ROUTINE** – add pink striped socks and switch shoes to pink high tops

Mini Kix (4-5th gr) – Arrive at 1:05pm

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: Blue biketard, leggings, black jazz shoes, silver hair bow, NO socks ***black socks from home will be worn for competition!

Middle Kix (6-7th gr) – Arrive at 1:05pm

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to each side of the bun

Uniform: Silver sequined biketard, nude bra, leggings, black jazz shoes, wide rhinestone barrette, NO socks ***black socks from home will be worn for competition!

Sr. Kix (8-12th gr) – Arrive at 1:05pm

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: Black sequined biketard, leggings, black jazz shoes, rhinestone barrette, NO socks ***black socks from home will be worn for competition!

Mini Jazz/Lyrical (4-5th gr) – Arrive at 1:05pm

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: Blue biketard, blue skirt, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, silver hair bow

Mini Pom (4-5th gr) – Arrive at 3:55pm (practicing before the second show)

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: Blue biketard, blue skirt, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, silver hair bow, set of pink poms

Mini Hip Hop (4-5th gr) – Arrive at 4:05pm (practicing before the second show)

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hat added

Uniform: Blue biketard, tan tights, pink striped socks, pink high tops, white bandana head wrap

Jr. Pom (6-12th gr) – Arrive at 1:05pm

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: Silver sequined biketard, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, wide rhinestone barrette, set of pink poms

Jr. Lyrical (6-12th gr) – Arrive at 1:05pm

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: Mauve skirted leo, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, rhinestone flower barrette

Jr. Jazz (6-12th gr) – Arrive at 3:55pm (practicing before the second show)

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back and hair piece added to the right of the bun

Uniform: Silver sequined biketard, tan tights, tan jazz shoes, wide rhinestone barrette

Jr. Hip Hop (6-12th gr) – Arrive at 4:05pm (practicing before the second show)

Hair: parted down the center, low bun with bangs pinned back, no hair piece

Uniform: Jersey, tank leo, foil biker shorts, pink high tops

K-3rd grade Pom Special Session – Arrive at 1:40pm

Hair: same as full season classes, leave hair pieces in

Uniform: Winter Show shirt, black leggings, white poms (same as last year)

PreK Father/Dancer Special Session – Arrive at 12:45pm

Hair: same as full season classes, leave hair pieces in

Uniform: Kids – Christmas/holiday dress from home (shorts underneath please), Guys – solid red shirt and jeans

Mother/Dancer Special Session – Arrive at 12:45pm

Hair: same as full season classes, leave hair pieces in

Uniform: Winter Show shirt, black leggings (kids and adults)

Winter Lights Special Session – Arrive at 12:45pm

Hair: same as full season classes, leave hair pieces in

Uniform: Solid black sweatshirt worn over whatever costume dancers performed in last; please be sure you ordered LIGHT STICKS (listed as required with class uniform pieces)

Additional Details: No jewelry is to be worn at performances, with the only exception being newly pierced ears that must keep studs in. Make-up is optional, though lipstick and blush are encouraged! Red lipstick will be required for competition, so now is a good time to practice wearing that. Please remember that gum is also not allowed at shows due to the choking hazard!
