E-MAIL

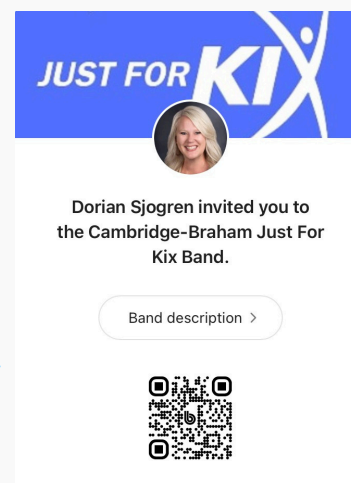

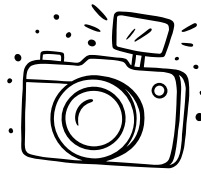

Always a little dancer favorite!! Our stage show!!

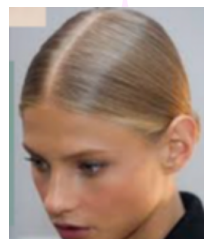
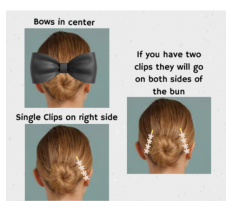
The performance is at the Princeton High School in the PAC.

Important information for class

What to wear....

- Dancers can wear any active clothing including leotards, tutus, shorts, leggings, tshirts, or tank tops. Clothing should not be baggy; loose fitting clothing makes it difficult for instructors to see the lines of a dancer's body, which is necessary for proper instruction.
- Shoes are required at class. Please be sure that your dancer has either her dance shoes or tennis shoes each week.
- Hair should be pulled back into a pony tail or bun. If dancer's hair is too short for a pony tail, please have as much of it pulled back out of the face as possible. No jewelry or gum at class please.

Water Bottles:

Please bring a labeled water bottle for dancers in 2-12th grade. Preschool and K-1 dancers do not need a water bottle- please do not send one with them.

Attendance:

Please make practices and performances a priority - your class and team depends on you! If you are absent, meet with a friend to learn the material before the next class.

Supervision:

Dancers are supervised during their regular class time. Although we may have several classes the same time, during the time prior to and after the class you will need to watch your children. We want them safe.

Entering and exiting...

- Dancers should enter and exit through the main entrance. We ask that you do NOT arrive any earlier than 5 minutes before your class starts.
- Parents of dancers in preschool through 3rd grade can walk your dancer into class as well as come to pick them up at the end. Dancers in 4-12th graders can enter on their own (if they are comfortable) and will be dismissed to find their adults at the end of practice.
- We strongly encourage parents to wait in their car after they walk their dancers in and then come back in at the end of classes for pick up. If you must wait- Please no running around or going into various rooms in the building. We are only allowed to be in the practice space and quietly sitting at tables if needed. **PLEASE DO NOT SIT IN THE HALLWAYS!!** Please be respectful of the facility. Pick up after yourself.
- This year we will invite Tiny Kix and Wee Petite parents into the room the last 5 minutes of class. For our 2-12th grade classes we will invite you in the last 5 minutes of class on the last practice of the month. This is subject to change. Dancers focus best with no distractions in the practice space.
- **Please put shoes and coats on in the hallway or entryway so we can start the next class as they run back to back.**
- If dancers are in multiple classes and have a short break, they can wait quietly at the tables between classes and have a snack if needed.
- Dancers may not invite friends who are not enrolled in Just For Kix to the building unless there is a parent present or it has been cleared with me.

WE OFFER A NO DISTRACTION ENVIRONMENT

Over the years, we have found the most productive way to run classes is without the distraction of parents and siblings in the room. We only have a short time each week, so every minute is important. Occasionally I will allow spectators in the last five minutes of class so you can see the progress we are making.
