# **Classes and Performance Notes**

### A FEW REMINDERS

Just a few reminders as we head into the second half of our dance season.

\*Our class time is limited and we need every minute of it. Please have your dancer arrive to class on time and prepared before class begins. Dance shoes should be on and hair should be pulled back.

\*Have your dancers remain in the hallway until it is their class time. As instructors, we need time to prepare for each class and sometimes only have 5 minutes between classes.

\*Send a water bottle with your dancer.

\*Please pick up any garbage you or your dancer may have left behind. We want to leave the facility in better shape than when we arrived.

\*Make sure to grab anything you brought with you to class. Things are left behind every week. We do our best to pick up after you but sometimes we aren't sure if it is something from the school or a dancer.

### WEATHER RELATED CANCELLATIONS

If the Anoka-Hennepin District cancels school or closes early, we will not hold Just For Kix classes. If school is held but weather is getting worse as the afternoon approaches, and I decide to cancel class I will do so by posting it on our website, Facebook pages, and Remind. Always use your best judgement. Sometimes the call has to be made early in the day and if conditions are not good for you to get to class, by all means your safety is priority.
