Entry Fees due April 6 – *Payment will open in your account three weeks prior*

- Dancers not paid by April 6 will practice out of formation for two weeks – still come to class because we will be working on our dances for Spring Show!
- Entry fees: \$45 one routine / \$68 two routines / \$82 three routines
- No spectator admission fee at the door – This is now covered under the entry fee!
- Just For Kix has adjusted the TWD fees to be in line with other competitive events. Instead of charging a spectator admission, the fees are charged to entrants up-front. Our entry fees are still far below what other competition companies charge.

Instructions to pay – *Payment will open in your account three weeks prior*

*Note: TWD fees cannot be paid on AutoPay like monthly class fees; they must be manually paid

 - Click Add+ to the right of the TWD [event location] item listing
 - It will then display the amount you are paying for
 - Click on the cart and proceed through the checkout process

Wristbands – Dancers cannot take the floor without a wristband, and the only way to get the wristband is to pay your TWD entry fees. These will be handed out the day of competition.

Individuals Not Attending – Let me know if your dancer cannot attend, and I will have the home office staff remove the fee from your account.

Wee Kix (Mon 6pm class) – one Kix routine

Starmakers (Mon 7pm class) – one Kix routine

When does my dancer need to be there?

Doors open 7:00 am. Arrive in uniform with hair done at the time stated below.

The Starmakers are welcome to stay with the Wee kix until after their awards to cheer on the other dancers. I highly encourage you to stay with your dancer after they are dismissed and watch some of the other dances. Watching other teams is a great way to get them inspired and to learn!

Hair/uniform

Uniform is the same as for all performances. Changing areas are limited, so arrive in uniform with hair and make-up done. Make sure your hair is VERY NEAT and styled like your team.

Wee Kix: Masked Mystery biketard, tan jazz shoes, tan tights, black flower hair piece, hair in a low bun with the flower clip on the right side of the bun, red lipstick

Starmakers: Chasing Stars biketard and skirt, tan jazz shoes, tan tights, rhinestone clip, hair in a low bun with the clip on the top of the bun, red lipstick

Competition Divisions

Competition divisions are grouped by grade range and class size. Your division may not have the same title as your normal class name. Awards will be presented in two formats: RANK and DIVISION PLACES.

RANK is based on the point total for each individual performance:

Silver	0-99 points	Platinum	200-249 points
Gold	100-149 points	Double Platinum	250-300 points
High Gold	150-199 points		

PLACES are based on how a team's point total compares to other teams in that division: 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place, etc. Rank does not correspond to place. Place and rank medals can be purchased at the event or online in your family account.

Divisions:

Wee Kix: Wee Kix 2 division- facing Side A

Starmakers: Mini Kix 4 division- facing Side B

There will be food & merchandise available for purchase. Don't eat in your uniform!
