Parking

TWD Sided Event:

This is a two sided event. Look in the gym and familiarize yourself with side A and B as well as the entrance and exit doors. If you have questions on this please find a JFK staff member and they would be happy to help you! Check the schedule for which side your dancer will face.

Wristbands:

Dancers are expected to wear their wristbands throughout the entire event. Directors will give wristbands to dancers if they are paid for the event.

We will have some paper copies of the schedules at the event. There will also be QR codes for you to scan on your device or print at home and bring it with.

Divisions:

Divisions are then made up through the following steps:

- The level that the Director registered the team for (classic, select or elite)
- The average grade of the dancers registered for the class. We do not adjust divisions based upon those in a class that can attend an event rather the average grade of the entire class.

Wee: 2-3.5 Mini: 3.51-5.5 Middle: 5.51-7.5 Junior: 7.51-9.5 Senior: 9.51-12
In the event of low participation, divisions may be combined in order to allow for adequately sized divisions.

Awards

We want to award as many teams as possible, while still leaving no less than two teams on the floor without a place. Point level ribbons will be given to all dancers entered in the competition even if they do not place. Teams that place in the top 2 of each category will receive a team plaque.

Point Total Ranks (Determined off of the total points from the 3 judges)

Silver - 0 - 99
Gold - 100 - 149
High Gold - 150 - 199
Platinum - 200 - 249
Double Platinum - 250 - 300

Award Guidelines (The team with the highest point total in the Division wins)

2 teams	Award 1-2nd place
3 teams	Award 1-3rd place
4 teams	Award 1-2nd place
5 teams	Award 1-3rd place
6 teams	Award 1-4th place
7 teams	Award 1-5th place
