3 yrs - 1st GRADE DANCER'S HAIR FOR SHOWS!

Dancer's hair should be worn in a nice curled ponytail (not high ponytail but not super low either) with no bangs in their face. Barrette should be worn right above the base of the ponytail.

2-9th GRADE DANCER'S HAIR FOR SHOWS AND COMPETITIONS!

You will need:

- *Tube sock with toe cut off and rolled up to look like donut, <u>OR</u> "Bun Sponge" from Claire's, <u>OR</u> round kitchen sponge with the middle cut out of it.
- *Hair net (same color as dancer's hair)
- *ponytail (2-3 thick)
- *bobby pins
- *Barrette that came with uniform
- *hairspray
- 1. Part dancer's hair on dancer's right side.
- 2. Put in LOW ponytail.
- 3. Take a tube sock (toe cut off) and roll it up so it looks like a donut. Or use the sponge from Claire's or a round kitchen sponge with middle cut out of it. If dancer has LONG or THICK hair... a bigger sock/sponge should be used.
- 4. put the sock around the ponytail.
- 5. evenly split ponytail so that entire sock is covered.
- 6. wrap a ponytail around the base of the ponytail.
- 7. pull loose hair around the ponytail and use bobby-pins to secure it.
- 8. A thin hair net is great to hold in loose hairs after bobby-pinning it.
- 9. Place diamond barrette on left side just above the ponytail.
- 10. HAIRSPRAY!!!! (Lots of it!)
