### TOGETHER WE DANCE COMPETITIONS

Please see the TWD note that is online. All dancers 2nd-12th grade (not including non-performing classes such as ballet, etc) will compete in at least one TWD competition this season. Remember this is a team sport so if there is a reason your dancer will not be able to attend the competition, please let their instructor know well in advance.

### WHAT IS A TWD or TOGETHER WE DANCE competition?

TOGETHER WE DANCE is the name of the Just For Kix Competitions that we enter. When kids hit 2nd grade they will compete. We typcially participate in 1-3 events per year and most involve driving. There is an extra expense of a competition fee. If your dancer is unable to attend any competition, notice should be given to the teacher well in advance for routine numbering purposes.

### SOLO/SMALL GROUP COMPETITION

This year we will again be offering solo and small group competitions. There are three locations for dancers to compete! Alexandria TWD (March 10th) Registration deadline 1/15, Eden Prairie TWD (Apr. 7th-8th) and Rochester Nationals (Apr. 27th-29th) If your dancer is interested in competing a solo or small group this year please contact ali@justforkix.com for approval. Thanks for your participation in the huge Holiday Shows!! We appreciate all your time and commitment.

We had a few people ask why we hold 3 shows. It is totally because of the large crowd. In the spring we can go down to 2 shows, as much of the crowd grows at the holiday show because of the Warrior Dance Team. We tried going down to 2 shows one year. People could not find enough seats and Cindy took their wrath. Many thought there were not that many different routines at each show that we could have had two. The number of DIFFERENT routines is misleading. There were 11 different routines at show one, 7 at show 2, and 9 different at show 3. The SONG NAMES may be the same...but the kids in them are different. For example we have 100 kindergarten and first graders and 4 different classes. We did Elvis Reindeer at 3 shows...but it was 3 separate sets of kids. That is one example and that happened numerous times with routines. Each class can have a great number of fans. For example if a class of 25 has 10 fans each. That is an influx of 250 people. Some said it was too long of a day for parents and kids. Know that we HEAR you as it is a long day for us too. (With set up and tear down it gets long, we would LOVE a shorter day. If we could ....we would.) We are going to try to omit some routines that do repeat for next year. Spring will be two shows. Maybe we can think of things to eliminate to make it shorter.

Some asked why we do not have it at Tornstrom. The stage is too small. We hope Brainerd will pass a referendum and finally get a performing arts center with a LARGE stage. It is HARD turning the gym into an intimate places to hold a show. We think we do pretty well with what we have. :)
