Admission:

Tickets will not be sold prior to this event. Cash only at the door, please. Dancers DO NOT pay to enter and perform. The admission price covers the school rental (cafeteria, gym and hallways), custodial fees, staff and other expenses.

Parking

White Bear Lake High School (South Campus) has several small parking lots and one large one. Please park in the large lot on the SOUTH side of the building. Parents are welcome to use other parking areas, but everyone MUST enter the building by using the main doors that face the South side parking lot (the doors have the school name above them). All other doors will be locked and an alarm will sound if opened.

When you arrive:

As you enter the building, you will arrive in the commons area of the high school. This is where you will pay your admission to enter the show. You cannot enter the building any further without paying admission (dancers do not pay admission).

Once your admission is paid, you will enter the cafeteria area: dancers in 4th-12th grade are welcome to turn right and enter the hallways where their team's storage area has been placed. Dancers in preschool through 3rd grade are welcome to come to the storage areas, as well, but should be supervised by an adult (please only one adult or less per dancer). Your Program Director may send you specific information about where younger dancers should go when they arrive.

The 2018 Metro Show:

The Metro Show is a way to bring Just For Kix dancers of all ages from all over the Twin Cities together into one show. It's a time to celebrate each other and celebrate dance! The show is run very similarly to how the Just For Kix Together We Dance competitions are run, so it provides our youngest dancers with a similar experience that our older, competitive dancers experience at those events. It also provides our competitive teams with a "practice run" for their competitive season.

The event:

The Metro Show event starts at 11 AM, but it will consist of multiple 50-55 minute shows with a 5-10 minute intermission at the end of each hour. Each show will start on the hour throughout the day. Dancers and families are not required to be there all day - your Program Director will send a schedule to you with your dancer's arrival and performance times. Once a dancer performs, he or she should watch the rest of the one hour show that they are in before leaving (that's good sportsmanship!) unless he or she needs to change for his or her next performance. Families are welcome to stay for the entire day, though.

Concessions will be offered by the White Bear Outback Bowl Performance Team.

Seating:

We will have a full crowd, but there will be enough seats for everyone. Please move toward the center of the bleachers as you sit, or as people leave around you, so there aren't a lot of empty seats or areas. If your dancer is performing in any other show than the first one at 11 AM, you will be entering the gym while another show is going on - know that many audience members will be leaving at the end of that show to make room for you. We promise that there will be a seat for everyone, but you may need to be patient and wait for your favorite spot.

Our routines are choreographed to be viewed from above, so every seat in the gym is a good one. We ask that the floor seats are reserved for those who are unable to climb the bleacher steps.

During the event:

When you enter the cafeteria and turn toward the gym, know that parents will enter the gym through the doors on the left, the dancers' chute (line up area) uses the door on the right. Please be sure to enter through the correct doorway.

Once a routine has begun, please refrain from moving until the music stops and the audience's cheering has quieted. Once your dancer is finished performing, he or she can either sit with you or some teammates in the bleachers and watch the remainder of the one-hour show OR go backstage and change uniforms to prepare for their next performance. Again, we ask you to please stay in your seats until the end of the show that your dancer is participating in. Some parents like to leave when their own dancer is done, but what about those parents who have dancers performing later in the show? They want a large audience for their dancer, too! So, please stay until the end of the one-hour show that your dancer is participating in. Thank you!

And remember, applause is ALWAYS welcome! When you see something you like while a team is performing, let them know. A dance performance is an interactive experience and the dancers LOVE hearing you cheer! Thank you!
