CLASS LOCATIONS:

Southshore Community Center: 5735 Country Club Road, Excelsior MN. Enter main door and we will be to your left down the hall.

Our Savior Lutheran Church: 23290 Hwy 7, Excelsior MN. Enter door number 5. Gymnasium is on your right.

CLASS DISCRIPTIONS:

TINY KIX: This class is designed for 4-5 year old dancers. They will work on overall movement while having fun. They will learn basic dance skills, coordination, balance, and following instructions. This class is a great introduction into the world of dance!

WEE PETITE KIX: This class is designed for K-1st grade dancers. This class will work on overall movement and basic dance skills. They will work on ballet positions, flexibility, basic turns and jumps, jazz and kick skills.

WEE KIX: This class is designed for 2^{nd} - 3^{rd} grade dancers. They will work on overall movement and basic dance skills along with basic dance positions, flexibility, turns and jumps, jazz and kick skills.

MINI KIX: This class is designed for 4^{th} - 5^{th} grade dancers. This class will focus on kick skills appropriate for this age level. This is a competition level class who will compete 3 times during the season.

MIDDLE KIX: This class is designed for 6^{th} - 7^{th} grade dancers. This class will focus on kick skills appropriate to this age level. This is a competition level class who will compete 3 times during the season.

SENIOR KIX: This class is designed for 8thth-12th grade dancers. This class will focus on kick skills appropriate to this age level. This is a competition level class who will compete 3 times during the season.

ADVANCED SENIOR KIX: This class is designed for 8^{th} - 12^{th} grade dancers who participate on a high school dance team. This class will focus on advanced kick skills. This is a competition level class who will compete 3 times during the season.

MINI JAZZ: This class is designed for 4th-5th grade dancers. This class will work on basic jazz skill appropriate for this age level. They will learn 1 jazz routine during the year and compete 1-2 times.

RISING STARS JAZZ: This is a placement jazz class designed for 6th-12th grade dancers. This class is an intermediate level jazz class. They will learn 1 jazz routine during the year and compete 3 times.

STAR MAKERS JAZZ: This is a placement jazz class designed for 6^{th} - 12^{th} grade dancers. This class is an advanced level jazz class. They will learn 1 jazz routine during the year and compete 3 times.

RISING STARS LYRICAL: This class is designed for 6^{th} - 12^{th} grade dancers who are looking to be introduced to lyrical. This is a beginner-intermediate level lyrical class.

STAR MAKERS LYRICAL: This class is designed for 6th-12th grade dancers. This is an advanced level lyrical class.

WHAT TO WEAR TO CLASS:

Wear tight fittings comfortable clothes you can move in. Jazz pants, shorts, leotards/tights, tank tops, etc. All dancers need to bring their jazz shoes to class. Dancers in 4^{th} - 12^{th} grade will also need to bring a pair or tennis shoes to class each week. Hair should always be pulled back tight in a pony tail or bun.

^{*}Lyrical classes will compete at the Rochester competition ONLY.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Online Registration -

Follow these instructions with how to register (everyone needs a new account)

- 1. Go to: classes.justforkix.com
- 2. Click on "Sign Up" in the Upper right hand corner.
- 3. Click "Sign up now"
- 4. Create an account Steps 1-3

This will be your family account. You should enter the parents/guardian information here. There will be a place to register individual students later.

5. Do a search on your Zip Code.

Only classes that apply to your child(ren) will show up in the listing. You can further filter the search by day/time or you can search by the course number listed by the class in the registration packet.

6. Add classes and uniform piece that you would like to register for and order. You can check out all at once at the end of the process. Registration and first month payment are due at time of registration.

IMPORTANT COSTUME INFORMATION:

NEW DANCERS: All items must be purchased. With the exception of shoes (if you already have the correct color of jazz shoes). See more information below.

FORMER JFK DANCERS: Shoes, bun forms, barrette, and some other costume pieces might be the same as last year. If you plan to use an item from last year, please be sure it is in good condition. Also please be sure the brand is the same. If different, you need to purchase a new one.

SHOES: Dancers can buy jazz shoes online or use their own. They must match the color of the costume online!

BUN FORMS: Only purchase one - either the blonde or brunette. Best match your dancer's hair color.

TIGHTS: I recommend getting new ones each year. They wear easily from year to year!

NOTE: Not all costumes match the pictures exactly. Some have been placed with leggings or shorts when basic pants are shown in the picture. Please order what you are supposed to order with the online check boxes.

ORDERING COSTUMES: I recommend now so you can be first on the list to get your costumes made. Dancers who get their costumes early in the season will have time for exchanges if needed versus those who wait last minute.

MINI JAZZ (4th-5th): With the jazz costume, you ONLY need to order the costume top. No need to order anything else with it! You will be ordering the shorts, tights and shoes with the kick costume already. They are the same for the jazz.
