We are so excited for the new dance season! Tiny Kix Class Meets on Mondays

Saturday October 26th-HALLOWEEN SHOW at West Fargo JFK Studio All are welcome for this free show! Dancers will show case all their wicked dance routines we have learned this month. Have your dancer arrive dressed in their costume. Arrival and performance times will be emailed out within the next couple weeks.

All uniforms & shoes must be ordered by September 30th to ensure arrival for our Winter Dance Show.

A few tips to help your young dancer be most successful at class:

- Dress in comfortable, easy to move in clothing. This may be a leotard and tutu or stretchy exercise clothes.
- Shoes: Ballet shoes are best! If these are not available during class, socks, tennis shoes or bare feet work just fine.
- Hair: Anything hanging in their eyes makes it difficult to focus on the fun so please do your best to have hair up and out of their face. Extra pony holders will be available at class if needed.
- Restrooms: These are located inside and to the left of the main senior center hall. Please ensure your child has used the restroom prior to class. We want to make the most of every moment of class and once one dancer has to go to the restroom, they all do :)
- DropOff: Please assist your child to line up in the south entryway and remain with them until the door opens at 6:00pm. A quick drop-off is usually best and we ask that parents of our young dancers remain on the premises (either in the kitchen area or parking lot) for safety purposes.
- PickUp: No dancer will be allowed to exit the practice space without an adult/responsible person. The kitchen area will be where all dancers will be dismissed to.
- Distraction Free Zone: It is important that our dancers can get the most out of class so we ask that parents and other family wait outside of the class area so that our dancers can focus on class. We will have time the last 5 minutes of class at the end of each month for parent to come observe what we are learning. Thank you for helping us make this a great learning environment!

If there is anything that you feel would be beneficial for me to know about your child, please let me know either at the beginning or end of class or feel free to email or call me anytime.
