



# Need To Know...

### **EARLY IS ON TIME - ON TIME IS LATE**

Just For Kix Teams start on time! Put forth your best effort to come prepared and ready to dance! Every dancer is needed from COUNT ONE to make a true practice, or performance, effective and organized.

### **ATTENDANCE**

Please make practices and performances a priority - your class and team depends on you! If you are absent, meet with a friend to learn the material before the next class. If you are absent the week of a performance you may not be able to perform.

### MESSES, THEFT, VANDALISM

Renting a facility is a privilege. Please treat the practice and performance space as if it were your own! We are all judged by the actions of a few. Therefore, Just For Kix has no tolerance for disrespecting others' belongings or property. We recommend leaving valuables at home.

### **SUPERVISION**

Dancers are supervised during their regular class time. Although we may have several classes the same day, during the time prior to and after the class you will need to watch your children. We want them safe.

### **CANCELLATION**

In the event that Just For Kix must cancel class, we will make the announcement in several locations. If school is cancelled or let out early for weather emergencies, we will not have class.

### CLASS PAYMENTS AND AUTO PAY

Class payments are always due on the 1st of each month.

To make your life easier you can sign up for auto pay and your payment will come out automatically on the 1st of each month. You need to do this EVERY year.

**HOW TO SIGN UP FOR AUTO PAY: (you need to do this every year)** 

Log into your dancers account at www.justforkix.com/danceclasses

- 1. Go to the "Payment/Classes" portion of the account.
- 2. Under the AutoPay column check with classes you want to be on Auto Pay. If you are in more than one class you must check it for each class.
- 3. Under the "Edit Credit Card" portion of the account you can select the card you want the payment to process on.
- 4. Log out

There will be a \$10.00 fee assessed to late payments. Student accounts are always required to be current prior to any class or performance. Any student with a balance due will not be eligible to perform with their team.

### What to wear....

- Dancers can wear any active clothing including leotards, tutus, shorts, leggings, tshirts, or tank tops. Clothing should not be baggy; loose fitting clothing makes it difficult for instructors to see the lines of a dancer's body, which is necessary for proper instruction.
- Shoes are required at class. Please be sure that your dancer has either her dance shoes or tennis shoes each week.
- Hair should be pulled back into a pony tail or bun. If dancer's hair is too short for a pony tail, please have as much of it pulled back out of the face as possible. No jewelry or gum at class please.



### Water Bottles:

Please bring a labeled water bottle for dancers in 2-12th grade. Preschool and K-1 dancers do not need a water bottle- please do not send one with them. No pop or food in gym







# Entering and exiting...

- Dancers should enter and exit through the main entrance. We ask that you do NOT arrive any earlier than 5 minutes before your class starts.
- Parents of dancers in preschool through 3rd grade can walk your dancer into class as well as come to pick them up at the end. Dancers in 4-12th graders can enter on their own (if they are comfortable) and will be dismissed to find their adults at the end of practice.
- We strongly encourage parents to wait in their car after they walk their dancers in and then come back in at the end of classes for pick up. If you must wait- Please no running around or going into various rooms in the building. We are only allowed to be in the practice space (gym) and the one particular hallway between the two gyms. The cafeteria will not be open for parents to sit in.. Please be respectful of the facility.
- This year we will invite Tiny Kix and Wee Petite parents into the room the last 5 minutes of class.
   For our 2-12th grade classes we will dismiss them when their class is over.
- Dancers may not invite friends who are not enrolled in Just For Kix to the building unless there is a parent present or it has been cleared with me.

### WE OFFER A NO DISTRACTION ENVIRONMENT

Over the years, we have found the most productive way to run classes is without the distraction of parents and siblings in the room. We only have a short time each week, so every minute is important. Occasionally (depending on the class) I will allow spectators in the last five minutes of class so you can see the progress we are making.
