Show Day Arrival Time for Dancers:

20 Minutes Prior to Showtime (preschool-1st grade)

30 Minutes Prior to Showtime (2nd-12th grade)

Dancers should arrive dressed in their first costume with hair done for performances. The dancer's staging area will be in the Gym on Court #1, behind the red curtain. To minimize congestion backstage, we kindly request that only ONE parent escorts dancers to the staging area both before and after the show.

Before the performance, dancers are to remain in the staging area with their team and avoid entering the main performance gym or the bleachers.

Parents of preschool dancers, please stay with your dancer backstage and then proceed to your seats 5 minutes before showtime.

Uniforms & Details

Performance Hairstyle and Costume Guidelines:

To ensure a polished and uniform look for our dance teams during performances, please follow the hairstyle and accessory instructions for your dancer's team.

Preschool - 1st Grade Dancers:

- Hair: High curly ponytail. For shorter hair, use a half-up curly ponytail.
- Accessories: Attach any uniform hair accessories (barrette, bow, flower) **on top or in front** of the ponytail.

2nd - 12th Grade Dancers:

- Hair: Part hair down the middle and secure it in a low bun. Use a bun builder, bobby pins, and plenty of hair spray to hold it in place.
- Accessories: Attach any uniform hair accessories to the **right side** of the bun.

Additional Guidelines for All Dancers:

- Remove all jewelry and watches; small stud earrings are permitted.
- Make-up is optional. For dancers in 4th - 12th grade, lipstick is recommended to make smiles visible from a distance.
- NO GUM during performances.
- If the costume is itchy dancers can wear a nude or same color leotard or tank top underneath their costume.
- Bras must be nude or clear and should not show through the costume.

Finale Routine Costume:

Dancers in Wee Kix, Mini Kix, Mini Pom, Mini Lyrical, Mini Hip Hop, Middle Kix, Middle Hip Hop, Senior Kix, and Senior Hip Hop will need:

- Spring Show Shirt
- Black leggings
- Dance shoes

What to Expect

Show Parking and Entrance:

Park in the main high school entrance parking lots, not the Auditorium lot. Enter the school building at the Activities Entrance by the glass doors of the weight room.

Items for Purchase at the Shows:

- Spring Show Shirt - If you did not purchase a spring show shirt online, there will be a limited supply available for purchase at the show.
- Flowers

What Should My Dancer Bring for the Show?

- Wear their first costume to the show, bring dance shoes to change into once at the school, bring additional costumes if in multiple classes and routines.
- Put dance costume items in a large tote or duffel bag to keep organized backstage.
- Blanket to sit on in staging area.
- Water bottle.

After the Show:

- Teeny Kix, Tiny Kix and Pre Petites: These younger dancers will perform towards the beginning of the show. Following their last performance, we will have them join their parents in the bleachers to watch the rest of the show.
- K-12th Grade: These dancers will stay with their class throughout the entire show. Following the last routine families can meet their dancer on the gym floor. You can take photos and congratulate your dancer. We will be clearing the gym 15 minutes after the show to prepare for the next show.
