

ADMISSION

\$6.00 adults / \$3.00 students
(Dancers competing do not pay admission at the door).

PARTICIPANT WRISTBANDS

I will receive wristbands for **paid** participants, which will be distributed the day of competition. Dancers will not be able to participate the day of competition without the wristband.

LUNCH/MONEY

There will be food & merchandise available for sale.

HAIR/UNIFORM

Uniform is the same for all performances. Changing areas are limited so it is best to arrive in uniform with hair and make-up done.

- HAIR MUST BE IN FULL PERFORMANCE BUN
- Some classes will perform in a pony tail, see * note below
- Your dancer will receive their lipstick and blush when they arrive.
- All kick dancers with pants must have black tights underneath.

NO GLITTER!

Teams wearing glitter may be disqualified. This is a facility issue – glitter is very hard to clean up off the performance floor.

HOW DO I FIND MY DANCER AFTER THE COMPETITION?

After awards, our group will go back to our assigned team area for pictures. Your dancer will then collect their belongings and will be excused to their parent's supervision.

DIRECTIONS/PARKING (from Richfield)
