

EXPLANATION OF PRESCHOOL DANCE CLASSES

Welcome to the crazy world of dance.

It can be very confusing when you first start, so I thought I would answer the most frequently asked questions. At anytime, if you have a question, please give me a call.

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WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE ALL YEAR CLASSES AND THE SESSIONS BROKEN INTO 5 OR 6 WEEK INCREMENTS?

The difference between full year and the shorter sessions is this. The full year is 32 weeks of instruction while the 4 sessions are 24 weeks. They are basically learning the same things. The shorter sessions have time off in between. There are advantages to both and you really can't go wrong with either. Some kids do not want time off, as they love going every week. Some kids need the break. The advantage of the full year class as a teacher is the group gets a comfortable feel, as the kids get to know each other.

There are 4 sessions for the kids enrolled in the 5 or 6 weeks sessions. Our hope is they do all 4 sessions. Families do deviate from that to accommodate their own needs. We do prefer they do all 4 as we need to fill the spots in the class. IF some do not do winter and then plan to do spring, the class can fill up

quickly.

COSTUMES: Costumes will be the same for the whole season. Make sure to size them up for the costume since it needs to fit until May. Early sign up will ensure you get the desired option.

SHOWS:
(4 MAIN SHOWS IN A YEAR)
We sometimes also perform at nursing homes, community events, etc.

HALLOWEEN SHOW
TYPE OF SHOW: Very low key WHERE: at Cross of Peace Church Parking Lot
DATE: October 12th
COSTUME: Wear their Halloween costume, one we provide, or something from home. Varies per class. Your child's teacher will let you know. COST: \$5 per dance family

HOLIDAY SHOW
TYPE OF SHOW: Large scale production, lighting, advance sale tickets, large crowd.
WHERE: Burnsville High School Gym DATE: Sunday December 7th (multiple

shows) your child will be in one. **COSTUME:** See class option. In most cases it is the same for Holiday, Kick off, and Spring Shows.

STAGE SHOW

TYPE OF SHOW: Low key, small admission fee. WHERE: TBD
DATE: Feb. 20th
COSTUME: They wear the costume listed for their class this will be the 2nd time they wear it.

SPRING SHOW

TYPE OF SHOW: Large scale production, lighting, advance sale tickets, large crowd.
WHERE: HS Gym - Location TBD
DATE: Saturday April 25th (multiple shows) your child will be in one.
COSTUME: See class option. In most cases it is the same for Holiday, Kick off, and Spring Shows.
