DANCERS

Arrival

Dancers should arrive 20 minutes prior to their show, dressed in their costume with their hair done. There will be bathrooms and changing tents for kids, if needed.

Staging Areas

Each class has a staging area to report to in the back hallway. We will have a dancer drop off area where coaches and helpers will lead them to their back area. If dancers have multiple costumes changes, it works great to use a laundry basket to organize, rather than a bag. Be sure that whatever they are using is labeled with their name. Please don't send dancers back with a bunch of excess items.

Once you're backstage

Once dancers are dropped off at the staging area, we ask that they stay with their class until the show is over. We don't want them wandering around or in the gym area without their instructor/helper at anytime.

Seating

We will have a big crowd, but there will be enough seats for everyone. Our routines are choreographed to be viewed from above, so every seat in the gym is a good one. We ask that the floor seats are reserved for our handicap spectators and those who cannot climb the bleachers

Chuck A Duck

At each show our Reliaquest Bowl Dancers provide a fun activity & stretch break for the audience called Chuck A Duck. This is a small fundraiser for them. You can choose to participate by paying \$1 to chuck a duck or \$3 to chuck and keep your duck. When announced the person who throws their duck the closest to the middle of the bullseye wins a prize valued between \$20-\$40. All proceeds go towards the dancers attending the next trip.

PARKING

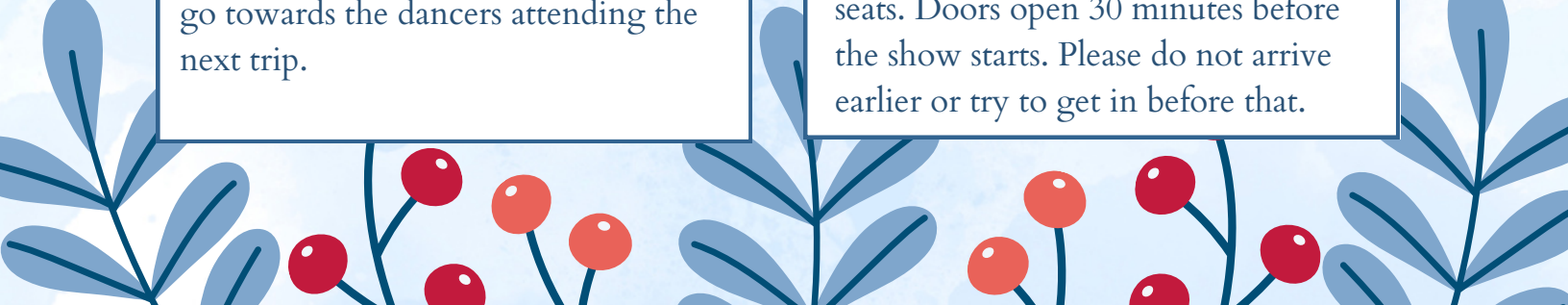

If you must leave your seat, please do so in-between numbers and do it quickly. Our dancers work hard and want everyone to be able to see their routine and enjoy it.

MINDFUL OF OTHERS

We've had comments from spectators of other smelling like marijuana at shows. We ask that all spectators please refrain from using it before and during a show. We want to remind everyone that this is a family friendly event.

APPLAUSE

Applause, cheering, woo -hooing is all welcome! When you see something you like while a team is performing, let them know. A dance performance is an interactive experience and dancers love to hear your support/enjoyment.

FLOWERS

Please support our dancers. They are fundraising to attend the Reliaquest Bowl down in Tampa Bay, Florida next December. These dancers have been working hard and would love your support at the show by purchasing flowers, water, or other goodies.

With this, no outside flowers are allowed at our shows. Please share this info with family and friends who may be attending. Outside flowers will be taken if brought in or asked for you to return them to your car.

Dancers Dismissal

After the Mass Routine, older dancers will clear the floor and we will bring out our Tiny, Teeny, Firecracker & Petite dancers to be connected with parents. We will spread out the classes. Please come down on the floor to get your dancer. Older dancers will come back out once they have their items from the back hallway & classrooms and are cleared.

PHOTO SPOTS

There will be multiple spots to snap great photos with your dancers after the show. We ask that you don't stand on the curtains or decorations. Please keep children from running around them or pulling on them. Thanks for respecting our setup & decorations.

REMINDERS

Dancers - no jewelry, nail polish or gum while dancing, Nails polished with a nude or clear color are fine.

Spectators - feel free to take photos & videos during the show. Please avoid using a flash while dancers are performing.

Jazz Opener will be performed by our Technique classes. Mass Routine will be the final number that includes all dancers in 4th-12th grade.
