Classes and Performance Notes

WINTER SHOW

Due to our start date of November 2nd we will not be having a Winter show this year. We decided adjust our spring show to be longer to accommodate for our late start. I am looking forwards to our awesome Spring show RED, WHITE and BLUE!

UNIFORMS

Uniforms are starting to come in. Since Just For Kix main office fills orders in the order that they were received throughout all Just For Kix programs it is hard to say how quickly your uniform will arrive. If you need to make an exchange due to size you will be able to do that on your account with Just For Kix. If there is a defect please contact me. Our first performance and class pictures will be in February so please make sure to order all uniform pieces are ordered by the end of December to make sure they will be here in time for those events.

BRING A FRIEND DAY

On November 30th we will have Bring a Friend Day. This is a day where we can have fun with our friends and show them our dances. I look forward to meeting all our dancers friends!

PARENTS AND GUEST CLASS PREVIEW TIME

The last 5 mins of each class we would love to have the parents come in to show off what we have learned that week. This is also a great way for our dancers to get used to dancing in front of people they may not know.

DANCER PICK UP- GRADE 3 AND YOUNGER

When picking your dancer up after class. Please come into the facility to get them. I ask that you come the last 5 minutes, we will perform for you, we will give brief announcements and then I will dismiss students to you. Classes run back to back so dancers not picked up will need to wait in the class area until their parent arrives.

FACILITY NOTES

We are so thankful to be able to hold classes at City Hall. They have asked a few things. When picking up dancers, please park

- and wait for dancers in designated parking spots, so that the police officers can access the front part of the building. They would like us to only use the community room area and the hallway outside of it. Please respect this and do not allow siblings etc, to use the gym and other areas within City Hall.
- Thank you for your help with these things. We want to continue to use this great facility.

SUPERVISION

- Dancers are only supervised during their regular class time.
- Although we may have several classes the same day, during the time prior to and after the class you will need to watch your children. Any siblings waiting also need to be supervised.

CANCELLATIONS

- As we enter the winter season, weather related cancellations can become an issue. We follow the MOC-FV school policy. If school has been cancelled or let out early we will not hold class.
- If you are in doubt as the weather conditions are worsening throughout they day, please know I will post any cancellations on KSOU, our JFK website, the Orange City Rec. page and will send out and email. Often we need to make this call early in the day and based on the information we know. Please always use your best judgement based on the conditions and where you live.

TEAMWORK

- One of our main focus areas at class is the concept of teamwork. We try to work lessons relating to the responsibilities, challenges and benefits of being part of a team into our weekly classes. You can reinforce these concepts at home by helping your dancer to think about how important they are to their team and how their actions related to practice, attendance and attitudes toward fellow team mates can have a negative or positive effect on the team as a whole. This concept helps dancers to feel apart of something bigger then themselves and helps them to develop thinking processes, leadership and motivational skills that will benefit them throughout their lives.
