Solo, Small Group Competition.

If you want to compete you need to follow the rules.

Bring your prepared routine to camp to take center stage! It's a great opportunity to become a stronger performer. Every dancer is encouraged to participate.

RULES

Interested dancers must come to camp with their routine prepared to perform to music on the first day. Solo (1) & Small Groups (2-5) dancers compete in the grade they will be going into in the next school year. (This is based on the oldest member in a small group.)

- No gymnastics or suggestive choreography may be used.
- We also require respectable music that has clean lyrics.
- Routine can be no longer than 90 seconds and CANNOT BE A JUST FOR KIX CLASS ROUTINE.
- Dancers can compete in both Solo & Small Group categories, however there is a \$15 charge; per person, per category.

All dancers will receive medals. The finalists are announced at the final camp show and will then perform for trophies.*

* In situations where there are fewer dancers, only the winner may perform.

If parents wish to watch the Camp Show they should report to the gym at 12:45 pm.

DAY 3 - Parents must pick up dancers after the Camp Show.

What do I wear and what do I need to bring?

Dancers should be dressed in dance or active wear each day along with their dance shoes or tennis shoes. Be sure to pack a water bottle and snacks.

Where is Registration?

Registration will take place in the lobby of Forestview Middle School
ADDRESS: 12149 Knollwood Dr. – Baxter, MN

What do I need to do at registration Day 1?

Be sure you get a nametag (Add serious medical conditions.)
Pick up your camp shirt. (Exchanges will be made at the end of the day.)
Check-in at the main registration table so staff can check you in.

Dancers will register from 8:30am-9:00am.

What time do I need to pick up my dancer after camp?

3:00pm each day.

What time is the show Day 3?

If parents wish to watch the Camp Show they should report to the gym at 12:45 pm. The show is at 1:00pm

What should I wear to the show?

Dancers will wear their camp T-shirt. This will be passed out at registration on Day 1. Shorts, booty shorts or jazz pants may be worn and can be any color.

About the Show: The show will be casual and expect it to be crowded. We ask that elderly are given chairs first and children sit on the floor. Go in knowing that you may have to stand.

- Water bottle and snacks (Label please)

- Make sure you turned in a medical release form
- PLEASE LABEL ALL BELONGINGS.

Important:

- Safety is one of our top concerns with our youth camps.
- Attendance is taken on the hour.
- We set up a buddy system between the students.
- If you are picking up your child early for any reason, please CHECK THEM OUT with the director. We do not want to think we are missing them.
- At registration, indicate if there is someone who should NOT be allowed to pick up your child.
- Parents must COME INSIDE to pick up their child.

The Final Show: The show will be held in the gym with limited seating around the perimeter. Much smaller than our normal shows, it will be low-key and focus on your child's age group, rather than all of them. We figure you really wish to see your child anyway!!!
